## Weekly Planner Ages 7 - 11



<b>3</b> <b>Credit and borrowing</b>	<b>Vault: Module 4</b> Pupils learn about credit and debt. (NB pupils must complete module 1 to progress to unlock modules) <a href="#">Access Vault on the EVERFI Platform</a> 	<b>Credit and borrowing</b> Pupils plan a school celebration and look at when it's ok to use credit and when it's best to use money you already have. <a href="#">Lesson activity</a>	<b>Credit (20 mins)</b> Pupils are tasked with writing a message to tell Charlie why you should be careful borrowing money. <a href="#">Weekly challenges</a>
<b>4</b> <b>Future planning</b>	<b>Vault: Module 5</b> Pupils learn that financial institutions, like banks, can help make our money grow.
